CANINES 8 YEARS AND OLDER (50 years and older in humans) / SPAY SURGICAL RELEASE (UNDER 10 LB)

Castration (neuter) is a surgical procedure which involves removing both testes. Your pet will be unable to reproduce after this surgery. If done early, this procedure can help prevent prostatic disease, cancer, aggressiveness, and roaming tendencies. This procedure requires a general anesthetic, the depth of which must be closely monitored. THIS IS NOT A SIMPLE ASSEMBLY LINE PROCEDURE. Several large blood vessels, nerves and the vas deferens must be ligated, and sterility must be maintained to prevent infection

Laboratory and ECG tests before an anesthetic or surgery, can help make us aware of unknown medical conditions that may make your pet a poor surgical risk, or indicate an increased likelihood of an adverse reaction to the anesthetic agent. In addition, these tests can help us discover many problems early on, before they cause unnecessary pain, expense... or worse.
