Caring For Your Pet After Surgery:

The after care you provide your pet is very important in ensuring a successful recovery

PLEASE NOTE

- Please note that the hair on your pet's leg(s) may be shaved at the injection site **<hence you might note some bruising. >**
- Please note that your pet may still be a little drowsy from anesthesia, this drowsiness should subside within 24 hours.

DO:

- Do keep your pet INDOORS confined to a small area with secure footing.
- Do keep your pet clean, warm and dry at all times.
- Do check the incision site daily **<Redness and minor swelling is normal. >**
- Do follow our instructions for feeding, exercise and medication carefully.

DO NOT:

- Do not allow your pet to lick the incision site, if your pet persists in doing so, please contact us **<we might send you home with a plastic lamp shape cone (i.e. "Elizabethan Collar"). >**
- Do not bathe your pet until the sutures are removed.

IMMEDIATELY CONTACT US IF YOU NOTICE:

- Bleeding, oozing, or swelling at the incision
- Your pet does not eat or drink for more than 24 hours
- Your pet vomits or fails to urinate or defecate
- Any abnormal behavior.
